

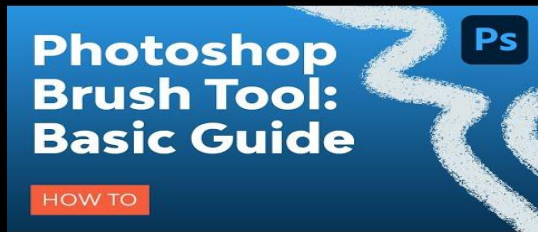


Drawing and Painting tools

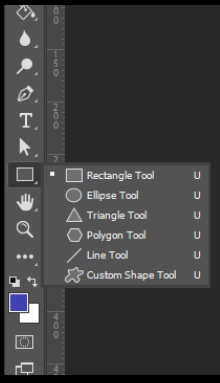

Shape tool is versatile you can draw lines, squares, place holders, use as frames and the custom shape tool has lots of shapes you can use.



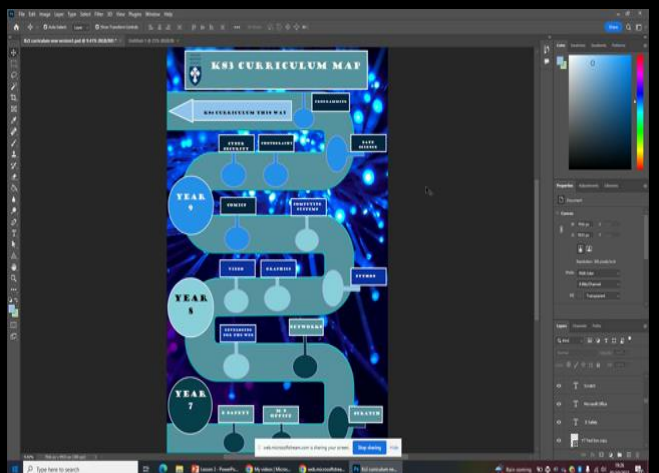
Layout Tools

1 Do one of the following:

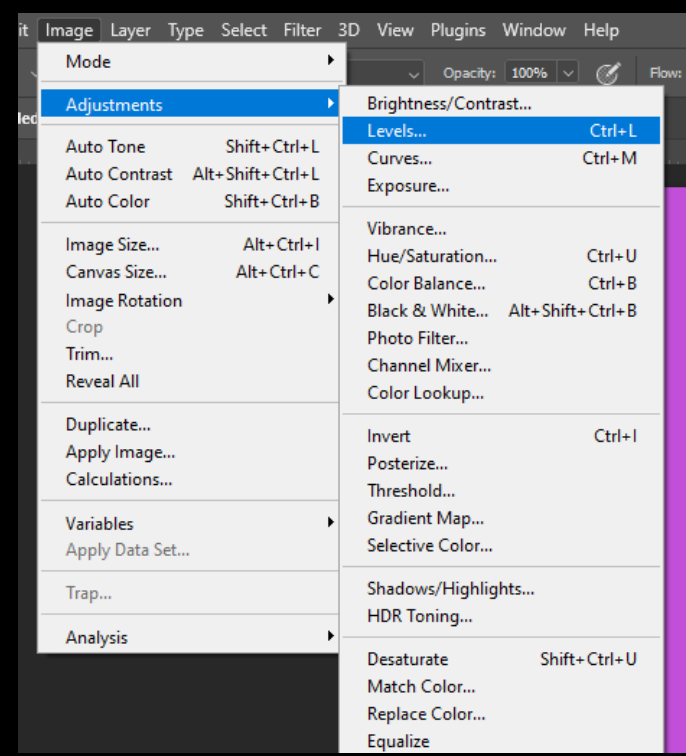
- Choose View > Show > Grid.

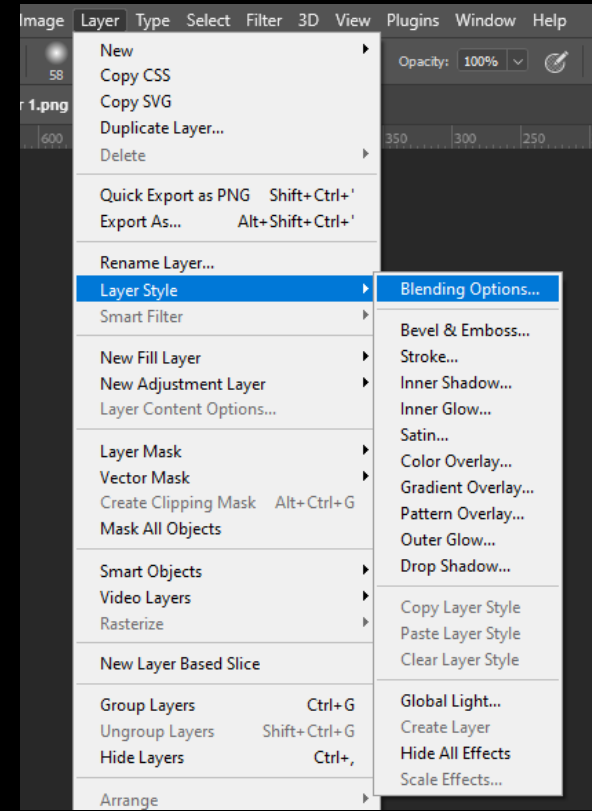
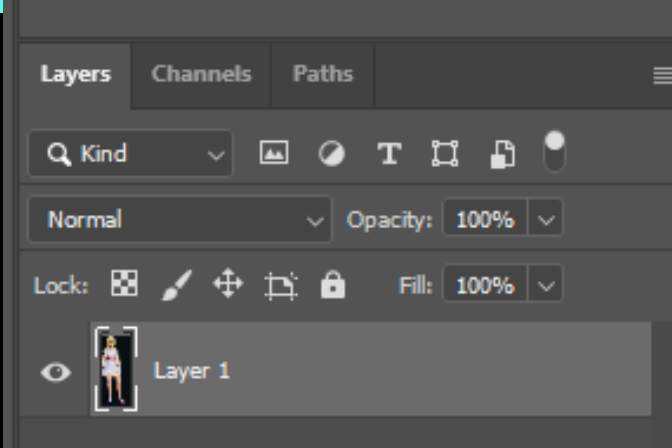
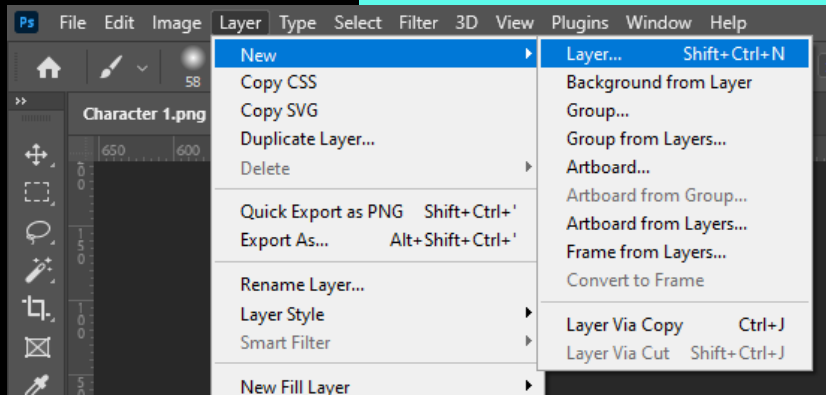
PS has a great filter gallery that you can evidence as skills to add some effects to your images





Layers

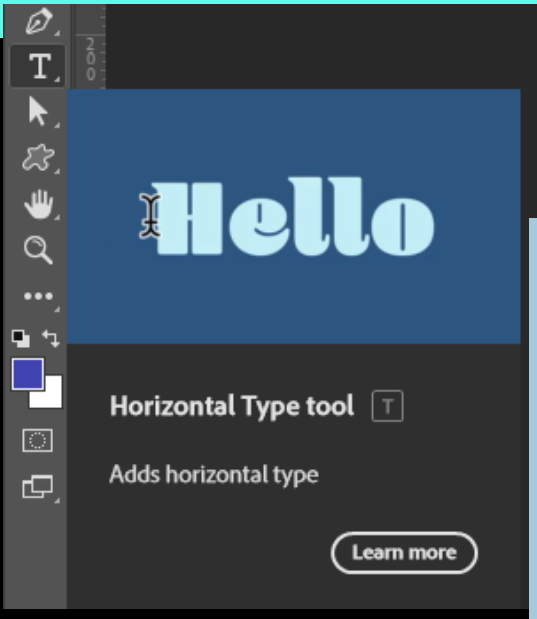
These allow you to compose your graphics. New layers can be added using the top menu or the layers palette. Layer styles also provide some good editing options

Retouching tools

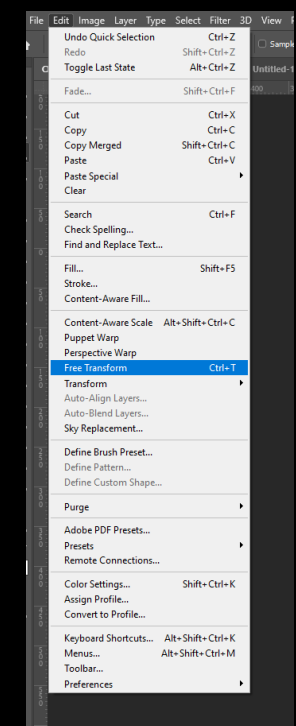
Clone Stamp, Healing, Patch, Blur, Sharpen, Smudge, Burn, Sponge.

Smudge tool pushes colours around using the mouse. Blur tools is good for blurring lines and softening edges. Burn tool will darken areas where the sponge tool will subtly change the colour saturation. Worth practicing and evidencing as skills
